At a Glance

Alpha Delta State Ohio Educational Foundation has served members and nonmembers through the following programs:

- **Student Teaching Grants (Esther H. Strickland)** assisted 40 students at Ohio public universities during their student teaching semester.
- **International Study Fellowships (A. Margaret Boyd)** supported three students from foreign countries who completed advanced degrees at a university in Ohio.
- **Leadership Development (Leadership Memorial)** provided support to three members for expenses related to the development of leadership knowledge, skills or experiences, and for expenses specifically related to nonprofit leadership core board participation.
- **Educational projects (Individual/Classroom/Community)** provided up to \$500 in financial support to six educators for educational projects for targeted learners in nonprofit settings and community-based projects.
- **Lifelong Learning** provided support to one member for expenses for ongoing, voluntary and self-motivated pursuit of knowledge for either personal or professional reasons, and provided funds for the biennial seminar presenter.
- **Scholarships** are available for members through the Margaret L White Scholarship at The Ohio State University, the Ruth Grimes Scholarship at Miami University, the Florence L. Woodward Scholarship at Kent State University, and the Annie Web Blanton Scholarship at any accredited university. Two Annie Web Blanton Scholarships were awarded.

ADSOEF is an all-volunteer 501(c)3 private charity that is managed by 10 elected directors.
